

These are exciting times in what the studies regarding the notion of the 'Self' are concerned. Nevertheless, the transdisciplinary approach (e.g. phenomenology, cognitive neurosciences, psychoanalysis, psychiatry) comes with a cost: a taxonomical confusion and fragmentation inherent to the proliferation of such distinct methodological approaches in between 1st Person Perspective (e.g. phenomenology) and 3rd Person Perspective (e.g. Neurosciences) approaches. Philosophy, given its general, far reaching, synoptic and conceptual tools, is specially suited to overcome this unfortunate scenario by providing conceptual clarification that facilitates the establishment of links between disciplines. This is also a general aim of the current workshop organized in collaboration between the IFL (FCSH-UNL) within its project "Cognitive Foundation of the Self" (PTDC-FIL-FCI/110978/2009) and the Center of Philosophy of Science at the University of Lisbon (CFCUL) that hosts this workshop: to clarify some conceptual fragmentation of the notion of 'Self' and deliver new insights in the philosophical study of the self.

Do we have to struggle conceptually and phenomenologically with a unity of self or rather with a disunity or deconstructive multiplicity of "aspects" and conceptions of the self and its experiential modes? What could be a determined self on the contrary of a self with free will? How can we describe the 1st person self according to Husserl? What could be a "neurochemical self" and what are 1PP "pharmakons" of a felt self (somatic or virtual) and its possible "enhancement"? These are some of the questions this workshop will introduce in a workfriendly atmosphere where will be time for debate and the exploration of new ideas.

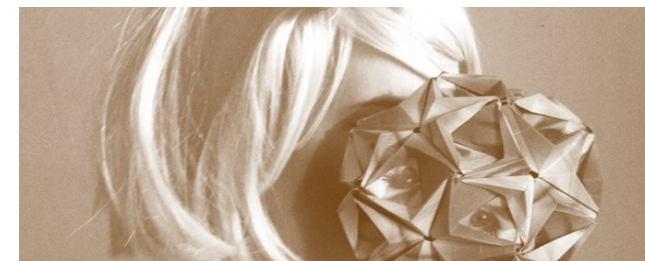
